Any work performed on a township road over, under, or within, the limits of a limited access state highway, requires a state permit.

The prescribed permit fee shall accompany the application and sketch. Schedules of fees are furnished on request.

THE FEE SHALL BE PAID BY CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS, AND SHALL BE MADE PAYABLE TO THE TOWNSHIP AFFECTED.

IMPORTANT

The terms and conditions embodied in this permit require the permittee to complete this work by the date specified in the permit. Where permittee fails to comply with the condition as to completion of work by the time specified, the following rules will govern:

- (a) Failure to start work by date specified for completion. Permit will be cancelled unless permittee desires an extension of time, in which case a supplemental permit may be issued.
- (b) **Work started and not completed by specified date.** Permittee will notify Township, prior to expiration of allotted time, of inability to complete the work on or before the date specified and request an extension of time. Such request shall be accompanied by the prescribed fee.
- (c) **Permittee not desirous of carrying out proposed work on account of change in conditions affecting it.** Permittee will notify the Township prior to the date specified for completion that work will not be carried forward, returning the permit with such notice. The fee for inspection of the work will be refunded by the Township, provided that they have been notified of cancellation prior to the expiration date.

The fees to be paid under the conditions in (a), (b), and (c) apply only to permits for which fees are collected in accordance with the fixed schedule.

All notices relative to time extensions or cancellations shall be forwarded to the Township which issued the original permit.


ACCESS TO AND OCCUPANCIES OF HIGHWAYS BY DRIVEWAYS AND LOCAL ROADS 67 PA CODE CHAPTER 1 PENN DOT

Grade of access driveway. (1) All driveways shall be constructed so as not to impair drainage within the right-of-way, alter the stability of the improved area or change the drainage of adjacent areas.

(2) Where a drainage ditch or swale exists, the permittee shall install adequate pipe under the driveway in accordance with Form 408. Drainage pipe installed under driveways shall be at least 15 inches in diameter.

(3) The side slopes for driveway embankments within the right-of-way shall not be steeper than ten to one. See Figure 6.

(4) Grade requirements in uncurbed shoulders within the right-of-way shall conform to Figure 1.



* The shoulder slope usually varies from $\frac{1}{2}$ "/ft.(4%) to 3/4"/ft.(6%). However, the shoulder slope should be maintained when constructing the driveway.

For grade changes greater than those shown in Figure 1, vertical curves at least 10 feet long shall be constructed and length "A" shall be increased.

Grades (G_2) shall be limited to 15% for minimum use driveways and from five percent to eight percent for low, medium or high volume driveways within the right-of-way.

- 2) Political subdivisions of the commonwealth, except when placing a facility longitudinally within more than 100 total linear feet of pavement. In that case, the application and inspection fees for pavement openings will be charged.
 Governmental authorities organized under the laws of the commonwealth.
- The federal government.
- Charitable organizations that are in compliance with Act No. 337, approved August 9, 1963, P.L. 628, as amended (churches, hospitals, schools tions, vaterans' organizations, non-profit organizations)
- Utility facility owners for:
 a) The installation of street lights at the request of PennDOT or the political subdivision.
 - b). The replacement or renewal of their facilities prior to a township resurfacing project after notice from the township.
 - The removal of poles and attached appurtenances.
 - d) Facilities moved at the request of PennDOT or the political subdivision.
 - The reconstruction or maintenance of their facilities that occupy the right-of-way under private status.
