The Treasurers Report was presented. A motion was made by Robert Boogertman to accept the Treasurers Report as presented, seconded by Jim Martin. The motion carried 3-0.

The bills totaling **\$70,735.93** from January 13, 2023 through February 09, 2023 were presented. Following a review, a motion was made by Bruce Chandler, seconded by Jim Martin to accept the bills as presented, and pay same. The motion carried 3-0.

Old Business

Ambulance Update: Robert Boogertman reported that Pennsylvania Ambulance has taken over Commonwealth Ambulance. He added that January's meeting did not take place due to bad weather conditions. Next meeting is scheduled for February 22, 2023. They do have proposals and will review to implement the next service of the fast car.

Short Term Rental Ordinance Update: Bruce Chandler provided an update that the Township will establish a date for Public Hearing on Short Term Rental Ordinance/Zoning Ordinance Amendments. Ordinances will be available on our Website and a copy will be available for public review at the Township Building. Public Hearing will be advertised in the newspaper and on our website.

New Business

Robert Boogertman made a motion for approval to advertise the Building Upgrade project for bid. Seconded by Jim Martin. The motion approved 2-1.

Bruce Chandler reported that a date for a Hearing to review the proposed Short Term Rental Ordinance/Zoning Ordinance Amendments. Jim Martin made a motion to set a hearing date Tuesday March 07, 2023 @ 6:30pm at the Lakeville Fire Company Hall. Seconded by Robert Boogertman. The motion carried 3-0.

The Lakeville Food Pantry will be held as a drive-thru in the Township parking lot on Thursday, February 23, 2023 from 10am-1pm.

Bruce Chandler reported that a date needs to be selected for the Great American Cleanup 2023. Karen Lutz who has organized this effort on behalf of the Township was present and proposed a date of Saturday April 22, 2023 and rain date of Sunday April 23, 2023. A motion was made by Bruce Chandler and seconded by Jim Martin to set this date. The motion was approved 3-0.

Jim Martin reported that there have been some general conversations about the property across the street that the Township owns. A number of residents are interested in Pickle ball courts, our existing park is maxed out! There are some Grant programs coming up related to recreational opportunities, that the Township should look into. A motion was made to pursue a grant by Jim Martin, seconded by Robert Boogertman. The motion was approved 3-0.

Open discussion on the floor regarding Short Term Rental Ordinance Hearing on what to expect.

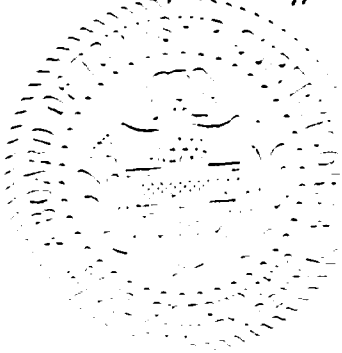
Adjournment
