

Paupack Township Board of Supervisors

Meeting Minutes of February 13, 2020

The Paupack Township Board of Supervisors conducted their monthly meeting on Thursday, February 13, 2020 at the Township Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM by Chairman Bruce Chandler.

Chairman Bruce Chandler opened the meeting by asking all present to participate in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bruce Chandler opened the meeting by saying that tonight we have our new appointed Supervisor, Robert Boogertman with us. He added that Leigh Gilbert had to resign because of conflict with the township code which required him to be a registered voter in Wayne County and he was not. Bruce Chandler said he is still working in the office on a daily basis.

The meeting minutes for the January 9, 2020 Board of Supervisors, the January 23, 2020 second monthly Board of Supervisors and the January 9, 2020 Zoning Ordinance Amendments Public Hearing were presented. Bruce Chandler made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, seconded by Jim Martin. The motion carried 3-0.

The Treasurers Report was presented. A motion was made by Jim Martin to accept the Treasurers Report as presented, seconded by Robert Boogertman. The motion carried 3-0.

The bills totaling \$41,665.24 from January 10, 2020 through February 13, 2020 were presented. Following a review, a motion was made by Jim Martin, and seconded by Robert Boogertman to accept the bills as presented, and pay same. The motion carried 3-0.

Nilsen Lot Combination (2019-17): This lot combination is located on a private road known as Ski Road in Paupack Township. Maps were submitted by James Motichka. Ron Bugaj wrote on the maps "approved but approval does not allow operation of quarry on site". Bruce Chandler made a motion to approve this lot combination with that exception, seconded by Robert Boogertman. The motion carried 3-0.

Reiter Lot Combination (2020-1): Maps were submitted by Joe Johnson. This lot consolidation is for four lots 186, 188, 165 and 167 going to one lot known as Lot 188R. Ron Bugaj said the map adequately shows this and he said he is satisfied with both the map and the deed. Jim Martin made a motion to approve this lot combination, seconded by Bruce Chandler. The motion carried 3-0.

Kiley Lot Combination (2020-2): Maps were submitted by Joe Johnson. Ron Bugaj said there were no adverse comments. He said the map and the deed are acceptable. Bruce Chandler made a motion to approve this lot combination, seconded by Jim Martin. Motion carried 3-0.

Bruce Chandler said we received a letter from Wayne Conservation District dated January 21, 2020 RE: General Permit (GP) Acknowledgment Notification Fred Lankford Dock. He said project was approved.

Bruce Chandler said we received a letter from Ron Bugaj dated January 23, 2020 regarding Hawley Ambulance. Robert Boogertman made a motion to lift the ban in Paupack Township if their licenses are all up to date and he is going to reach out to them to get this information before we send a letter to 911. He said he will follow up with the organization to make sure everything is in place. Ron Bugaj added we will not do anything until we hear from Robert and he has the documentation then the township secretary will send the letter. This was seconded by Jim Martin. The motion carried 3-0.

Bruce Chandler said we received a letter from ENTECH Engineering regarding WLE. Ron Bugaj said that WLE is applying for a Public Water Supply Permit for the purpose of installing chemical feed equipment for sequestering low levels of iron and manganese. Ron added if anyone wants to view it, it is public record here at the township.

Bruce Chandler said we received an email from the US Census Bureau and they are looking for hundreds of people and they can be contacted at 484-781-6178.

Bruce Chandler said we received the Wayne Tomorrow! Monthly newsletter for February 2020, Volume 1, Issue 2. It is at the front table for viewing.

New Business

Bruce Chandler said we appointed a new Township Supervisor, Robert Boogertman.

The Great American Cleanup is set for Saturday, April 18th at 8:30 am with a rain date of April 19th at 8:30 at the township. Karen Lutz said she changed the litter poster to say Pick Up Pennsylvania Day. She added that she officially adopted a big chunk of 590 from Lakeshore to Hoadleys Road so this will be part of the April 18th cleanup. She said that someone made the suggestion to her of "Keep Paupack Township Beautiful" and this will be the second line on the Adopt A Highway Sign.

Bruce Chandler mentioned that there was a tremendous amount of garbage tossed on both sides of the road by Wangaum Falls by Camp Watonka. Jon Castimore contacted the Fish Commission and they are investigating it. Bruce said the fine is going to be stiff. Bob Kiley added that this should be put in the newspaper to let people know there are consequences. Ron Bugaj said he will help us with a Litter Ordinance and getting signs put up.


Paupack Township Spring Cleanup is set for Saturday, May 16th from 8:00 am to noon.
