The Paupack Township Board of Supervisors conducted their monthly meeting on Thursday, April 8, 2021 at the Township Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM by Chairperson Bruce Chandler.

The Lakeville Food Pantry will be held as a drive-thru in the Township parking lot on Thursday, April 22, 2021.

Bruce Chandler reported that we received a letter from Damascus Township dated March 12, 2021 regarding a lawsuit that Senator Lisa Baker, Senator Gene Yaw, Damascus Township, and the Wayne County Commissioners have entered into against the Delaware River Basin Commission. Bruce reported that the Township will support them but will not sign or adopt the Resolution.

Public Comment

Katie Collins asked about how many families the food pantry feeds a month. Bruce Chandler reported roughly 140 families depending on the time of the year.

Andy Andersen brought up short-term rentals and asked how the Township plans on controlling this. Ron Bugaj reported that this is being worked out in the revised Zoning Ordinance that the Planning Commission is currently working on.

Katie Collins asked about the new pipe project that is displayed in the Township. Robert Boogertman reported that this project is supposed to start sometime in 2022 or 2023.


Chris Rosler introduced himself. He said he is running for Sheriff of Wayne County on Election Day in May.
