



**Big Bear Update:** Supervisors Tom Oakley and Bruce Chandler and SEO Chris Martin have been out to the site. The drip system still needs to be done. Tom Oakley noted that there have been no updates from Laurel since December 2012. However, he said she called last week and proposed that since they have a 30,000 capacity holding tank they would like to begin using the system. Her thought being that the drip system would be in place by the time the tank reaches full capacity. The Supervisors and Solicitor are all in agreement that they do not want to grant this usage. All agreed that total completion of the drip system should be done before they allow it.

**Sanford/Silver Spruce Subdivision:** A request for an extension has been submitted to the Supervisors. The extension has been granted to September 13, 2012.

**Ceiling Replacement for Township Building:** The Township has received three bids from contractors. A motion was made by Tom Oakley to accept the lowest bid which is from Grimm Construction. The bid amount is for \$9429.00 which includes replacement of the insulation and ceiling and \$1045.00 for installing the new lighting. The motion was seconded by Leigh Gilbert. All approved.

**Pole Barn Update:** At this time, we are waiting for the prevailing wage reform to be passed. It is in our best interest to wait until the Bill is signed which will save the Township approximately 20%.

**Building & Zoning Update:** Leigh Gilbert gave an update on building and zoning permits applied for in the month of March, 2012.

**Spring Clean Up:** The Township Spring Clean Up is scheduled for June 2, 2012 from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm.

**Great American Clean Up:** The Great American Clean Up is scheduled for April 21, 2012 from 9:00am to 12:00 pm. We are still looking for volunteers.


**Township Building Closing:** The Township Building will be closed on Election Day April 24, 2012 for voting.
