

Paupack Township Board of Supervisors

April 12, 2018

The Paupack Township Board of Supervisors conducted their monthly meeting on Thursday April 12, 2018 at the Township Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order at 6:34 PM by Chairman Bruce Chandler.

Chairman Bruce Chandler opened the meeting by asking all present to participate in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The meeting minutes for March 8, 2018 Board of Supervisors were presented. A motion was made by Jim Martin, and seconded by Leigh Gilbert, to approve the minutes as presented. The motion carried 3 – 0.

The Treasurers Report was presented. A motion was made by Leigh Gilbert, and seconded by Bruce Chandler to accept the Treasurers Report as presented. The motion carried 3 – 0.

The bills totaling \$57,016.91 from March 9, 2018 Through April 12, 2018 were presented. Following a review, a motion was made by Leigh Gilbert, and seconded by Jim Martin to accept the bills as presented, and pay same. The motion carried 3 – 0.

Subdivisions:

There were no subdivisions

The Great American Clean up: This event will be held on April 28, 2018, with a rain date of April 29, 2018. There was discussion regarding advertising. Flyers will be made and distributed around the Township. Karen Lutz will Chair this event with assistance from Marianne Unger, Paupack Township's Secretary/Treasurer.

Building & Zoning: For the month of March there were 2 Houses, 2 Additions, 1 Barn, and 1 Shed.

Fire Call Log: Information was not received in time for the meeting.

Ambulance Call Log: Information was not received in time for the meeting.

Driveway Permit: A driveway permit was issued for #6 Crane Road.

Lakeville Volunteer Fire Company: Supervisor Jim Martin is working on a grant to help the fire company replace their air packs. Jim states that their air packs have reached their life expediency. The plus side is, by upgrading the systems now we can move the equipment into new technology. Things like a heads up display that gives the fire fighter an instant reading of his/her air supply. More information will be available at the May meeting.

Update on the Comprehensive Plan: Jim Martin gave a brief update on the progress being made on the Plan. He also mentioned that the workshops are nearly complete, which brings us to the public viewing. The public viewings will take place in Hawley Borough, and Paupack Township. The times and dates of the public viewing will likely be established at the May meeting.

Correspondence:

- The Township has received three (3) separate audit reports from Brian T. Kelley & Associates for the 2017 audit. It was announced that the reports were on the front table for anyone wishing to see them.
- The Township has received a letter from Wayne County Conservation stating that a soil & erosion plan is waved for Mr. Lummis's dock relocation.

- The Township received notification from Bunnell Waste Removal that the fees are going to be raised.

Old Business:

Fauk and Lapardo: There was a discussion regarding which avenue to take with Mr. Fauk. It was mentioned that the building has been stabilized, and secured. It was brought to the attention of the Supervisors that the contractor has left the job, and nothing is being done. The Township will do an inspection to determine the status of the work. It was also brought up that the Township has not received the \$8,000.00 fine awarded to us by Judge Carney. Bruce Chandler made a motion to have Solicitor Bugaj look into this issue, seconded by Jim Martin. The motion carried 3 – 0.

New Business:

There was no new business to be heard.

Public Comment:

A decision was made to have a Paupack Township Clean up Day on Saturday June 2, 2018 from 8:00 AM to 12:00 Noon.

Bruce Chandler did a narrative on storm policy, school closings, and weather forecasting in general.

Chairman Chandler announced that Glen Tennant, our shop guy, will be leaving us following timely notice.

Chairman Chandler asked if there was anything further to come before the Board. Hearing none the meeting was adjourned at 7:04 PM
