

Paupack Township Board of Supervisors
Meeting Minutes of May 27, 2021

The Paupack Township Board of Supervisors conducted their 2nd monthly meeting on Thursday, May 27, 2021 at the Township Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order at 3:00 PM by Chairperson Bruce Chandler.

New Business

Robert Boogertman reported that Pioneer Pole Buildings was contacted by the Township. They submitted a bid service contract to construct and to connect the two existing buildings. He added that they are Costars compliant and their bid is \$160,939.00 for labor and material with prevailing wage included. He added that this bid does not include flooring or installation. Robert Boogertman made a motion to award the bid to Pioneer Pole Buildings, Inc. to proceed with the addition, seconded by Jim Martin. The motion carried 3-0.

Bruce Chandler made a second motion to have Robert Boogertman oversee the job as it proceeds, seconded by Jim Martin. The motion carried 3-0.

Bruce Chandler reported that the Township received four bids for a grader, two from John Deere, Five Star Dunmore and two from Bradco, Inc. from Towanda, PA. The first one is for the machine that we are currently renting, which is a 1997 John Deere 672CH for \$50,581.00 which included the new turbo and the rental applied to it which is \$7900.00 which brought the price down to \$42,681.51. Five Star dropped off an alternate bid for a 2013 John Deere 672G that is in stock for \$175,000.00 with 1470 hours on the machine.


Bradco submitted a bid for a 2017 672GP John Deere with 1900 hours on the machine for \$185,000 and a 2016 John Deere 772 with 2400 hours on the machine for \$180,000.

Robert Boogertman made a motion to purchase the low cost grader from Five Star for \$42,681.51, seconded by Jim Martin. The motion carried 3-0.
