

Paupack Township Board of Supervisors

Meeting Minutes of June 14, 2018

The Paupack Township Board of Supervisors conducted their monthly meeting on Thursday June 14, 2018 at the Township Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order at 6:34 PM by Chairman Bruce Chandler.

Chairman Bruce Chandler opened the meeting by asking all present to participate in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The meeting minutes for May 10, 2018 Board of Supervisors were presented. Leigh Gilbert made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, seconded by Jim Martin. The motion carried 3 - 0.

The Treasures Report was presented. A motion was made by Jim Martin to accept the Treasurers Report as presented, seconded by Bruce Chandler. The motion carried 3 - 0.

The bills totaling \$81,107.27 from May 11, 2018 through June 14, 2018 were presented. Following a review, a motion was made by Leigh Gilbert, and seconded by Jim Martin to accept the bills as presented, and pay same. The motion carried 3 - 0.

Subdivisions

Mengal - 2018-6: this subdivision is a lot consolidation. Following a review by the Supervisors, Solicitor Bugaj stated that the deed was good. Bruce Chandler made a motion to approve this lot consolidation, seconded by Jim Martin. All were in favor of the lot consolidation. The vote was unanimous.

New Hire

Property Maintenance Issues

An update was given regarding the Lapardo/Fauk issue by Solicitor Bugaj. The explanation stated that the fine of \$8,000 has not been received. Attorney Bugaj will be filing the necessary paperwork for the condemnation of this property at a higher court, at the direction of the Supervisors. Jim Martin made a motion to have Solicitor Bugaj move forward with the condemnation proceedings, seconded by Bruce Chandler. The vote carried 3 - 0.

John Deere Financial

The first payment is going out to John Deere in the amount of \$48,853.99 for the new loader we purchased last year.

The Comprehensive Plan

The Comprehensive Plan remains on target with a public viewing scheduled in Hawley on 10 July 2018 at 6:00 PM. Paupack Township will host the next viewing on 8 August 2018 at 6:30 PM.
