The Paupack Township Board of Supervisors met on the above date at 7:30 P.M. at the Municipal Building. The minutes of the May 13th meeting were presented and approved as written.

A Treasurer's report was given. Leigh Gilbert made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report seconded by Thomas Oakley – vote unanimous.

The bills were presented. Thomas Oakley made a motion to pay them seconded by Leigh Gilbert – vote unanimous.

There were no subdivisions.

Thomas Oakley made a motion to do a study on the posting and bonding of township roads seconded by Leigh Gilbert – vote unanimous.

Bruce Chandler made a motion to release the fire tax money and also the ambulance tax money which will be on a monthly basis for the ambulance as discussed with Sharon Gumpfer seconded by Leigh Gilbert – vote unanimous.

The food pantry will be held on June 24th from 11:00 until 2:00 P.M.

The spring clean up held on June 5th was a success. There were three full dumpsters and also the metal bin was filled.

The board announced that the Christopherson property has been purchased by the township. It is going to be used as a secondary park in the future. A grant was applied for at \$34,000.00 through the state. The taxes for the township on this property are \$41.00 a year. Also the fire company is going to use the buildings for training.

Bruce Chandler made a motion to advertise a hearing on August 12th at 7:15 P.M. for the review of the SALDO seconded by Thomas Oakley – vote unanimous. It will then be adopted at the regular meeting.

Bruce Chandler made a motion to submit a grant for the one quarter million gaming from Monroe County seconded by Thomas Oakley – vote unanimous. The board stated that the money will be used to replace a truck, backhoe and possibly a cold storage building.

Bruce Chandler made a motion to accept Shepstone Management Associates contract seconded by Leigh Gilbert – vote unanimous.

There were a total of seventy permits issued since January 2010.

Bruce Chandler made a motion to be in attendance for a public meeting with Palmyra Township, Wayne County seconded by Leigh Gilbert – vote unanimous.

Leigh Gilbert applauded the road crew for the work being done at the recreation park and also for all the work being done for the new addition to the park and also for informing the neighbor of what was being done. The property owner was very glad to see something being done.

Bruce Chandler authorized a purchase for a new xerox copier or similar copier which meets the needs of the township from the Costars contract.

Those present were board members, (Bruce, Leigh, Tom), Secretary, Solicitor and Chairman Chandler who conducted the meeting which adjourned at 7:50 P.M. Names of those present are herein filed.
