Old Business

Kuhnsman-2024-9 – A motion to approve the Conditional Use Application as submitted by Chris Kuhnsman and Kimberly R. Bojczuk Tax Map ID#19-0-0006-0016 located at 74 Paupack Point Road, was made by Jim Martin and seconded by Robert Boogertman subject to the conditions as contained within the written decision. Motion carried 3-0. A copy of the written decision will be mailed to the owners of the property. A copy of the written decision will also be provided to the Paupack Township STR Compliance Officer and the Paupack Township Zoning Officer.
