Mountaintop Storage Land Development 2022-013: Lou Cozza from Kiley Associates was present to discuss this proposed Land Development. Ron Bugaj reported that the Planning Commission recommended approval.

Pocono Sign Land Development 2022-015: John Young from Woodland Design was present to discuss this proposed Land Development and hand out a new top sheet of the map. John Young said we received the County Letter and all the comments were addressed. He also said the sewage permit is in process with SEO, Chris Martin. It is also under DEP review. Ron Bugaj said that the Planning Commission has recommended approval contingent on the County Letter.

Robert Boogertman made a motion to approve this Land Development, seconded by Jim Martin. The motion carried 3-0.

Karen Lutz asked if she could schedule a date for the Fall Litter Cleanup. The Supervisors decided on Saturday, September 24th for the cleanup.


New Business
