

Paupack Township Board of Supervisors

Extra Meeting August 24, 2017

The Paupack Township Board of Supervisors conducted their second monthly meeting on Thursday August 24, 2017 at the Township Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bruce Chandler.

Purpose of the second meeting

The purpose of the second meeting was to discuss the performance of the builder responsible for the Dollar General Project, and decide if their performance justifies a reduction in their performance bond.

The following Township Officials were present at the meeting

Bruce Chandler, Chairman James Martin, Supervisor Leigh Gilbert, Supervisor

The following members of the public were present at the meeting

There were no members of the public present for the meeting.

Following a review, and discussion by the Supervisors, they felt that a reduction was in order. The remaining items that are not complete, which are the sign on the building, and soil and erosion issues could be more than covered if the Township has to complete them. Therefore, a motion was made by Jim Martin, and seconded by Leigh Gilbert to reduce the amount of the security to \$20,000.00, and return to the contractor \$200,080.30 as a reduction in the amount of the security held. Jim Martin voted Yes, Leigh Gilbert voted Yes, Bruce Chandler abstained. The motion carried.

There was discussion regarding changing the Township's Fall Cleanup Day. Normally the clean-up day is held the first Saturday in September. The first Saturday this year falls on Labor Day Weekend. Leigh Gilbert made a motion, seconded by Bruce Chandler to move the clean-up day to the next Saturday which is September 16, 2017 from 8:00 AM to 12:00 noon.

With no further business to come before the board, Chairman Chandler adjourned the meeting at 3:14 PM.
