

Paupack Township Board of Supervisors

Meeting Minutes
September 10, 2015

The Paupack Township Board of Supervisors conducted their monthly meeting on Thursday, September 10, 2015 at the Township Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 P.M. by Chairperson Bruce Chandler.

Chairperson Bruce Chandler opened the meeting by asking all present to participate in the Pledge of Allegiance. The minutes of the August 13, 2015 Board of Supervisors meeting were presented. A motion was made by Leigh Gilbert to approve the meeting minutes with corrections to be made to the spelling of Steve Rabel's name. The motion was seconded by Tom Oakley. The motion carried 3-0.

The Treasurer's Report was presented. Tom Oakley made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report as submitted seconded by Leigh Gilbert. The motion carried 3-0.

The bills, totaling \$34,085.31 were presented. Following a review, Leigh Gilbert made a motion to accept the bills as presented, and pay same, August 14, 2015 to September 10, 2015. Tom Oakley seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0. A list of the bills is on file.

2016 Minimum Municipal Obligation (MMO) for Pension Plan: A motion was made by Tom Oakley seconded by Leigh Gilbert to approve. The motion carried 3-0.

Watershed Funding: A motion was made by Tom Oakley to fund the Watershed in the amount of \$10,000.00. The motion was seconded by Leigh Gilbert. Motion carried 3-0.

Disbursement of Fire Taxes: A motion was made by Bruce Chandler seconded by Tom Oakley to release the remaining fire tax monies to the Lakeville Volunteer Fire Company.

Township Fall Clean Up: Saturday, September 12, 2015 from 8am to noon. No hazardous materials will be accepted.

Firehouse Update: Tom Oakley spoke about the cleanup efforts after the recent fire at the firehouse. The process is progressing and he commended all the volunteer firefighters and local residents who

have given so much time and support to make things happen quickly. He also mentioned that the chicken BBQ was a great success.

Fire log: There were 12 calls for the month of August.

Ambulance log: There were 56 calls in July and 40 calls during the month of August.

Building & Zoning Updates: Supervisor Leigh Gilbert gave an update. There were 13 permit applications for the month of August.

Correspondence: None

Old Business: The Lakeville Food Pantry Inc. 501c3 paperwork is progressing. The EIN number has been received and a checking account has been opened.

The salt shed is completed. About 80 of the grading is done.

The pole barn should begin being built on or around September 21, 2015 and should be completed before winter.

Frank Williams, on behalf of the Hemlock School Association, stated that the event held at the schoolhouse on August 25th was a success. They had a good turnout and lots of positive feedback and raised approximately \$1250.00.

Public Comment: A question was raised whether the township would support enacting a renter's ordinance sometime in the near future. Pros and cons were discussed.

Having no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 7:00 pm by Chairperson Bruce Chandler.
