

Paupack Township Board of Supervisors

Meeting Minutes

October 9, 2014

The Paupack Township Board of Supervisors conducted their monthly meeting on Thursday, October 9, 2014 at the Township Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 P.M. by Supervisor Tom Oakley.

The following Township Officials were present at the meeting:

Supervisor Tom Oakley opened the meeting by asking all present to participate in the Pledge of Allegiance. The minutes of the August 28, 2014 and September 11, 2014 Supervisors meetings were presented. A motion was made by Tom Oakley to approve the meeting minutes seconded by Leigh Gilbert. The motion carried 2-0.

The Treasurer's Report was presented. Tom Oakley made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report as submitted seconded by Leigh Gilbert. The motion carried 2-0.

The bills, totaling \$130,895.20, were presented. Following a review, Tom Oakley made a motion to accept the bills as presented, and pay same, September 12, 2014 to October 9, 2014. Leigh Gilbert seconded the motion. The motion carried 2-0. A list of the bills is on file.

Minimum Municipal Obligation: A motion was made by Tom Oakley to approve the Minimum Municipal Obligation for 2015 in the amount of \$16,699 seconded by Leigh Gilbert. Motion carried 2-0.

Budget Workshop: A budget workshop will be held on October 23, 2014 at 3:00pm for the purpose of establishing the budget for the year 2015.

Election Day: Election Day is November 4, 2014. Township building will be closed for normal business and opened for the polls.

Cove Haven Extension: The deadline for the extension was October 1, 2014. HSS surveyors did not follow through with requested conditions set forth by the Board of Supervisors. A motion was made by Tom Oakley seconded by Leigh Gilbert to deny any further extensions.

Goose Pond Road Accident Issue: Solicitor Bugaj stated there are no details to discuss at this point and he will update us at next month's meeting.

Paradise Point Zoning Issue: The owners have responded and complied. The issue is now resolved.

Woodland Hills Septic Issue: The owner is cooperating and is increasing the septic system capacity an additional fifty per cent. The issue is in the process of being resolved.

Hoadleys Road Property Maintenance Issue: The owner is making changes and there is some progress with the roaming chickens. The line of sight issue still remains. The supervisors have instructed Solicitor Bugaj to hold off on the complaint for the time being.

Building & Zoning Updates: Supervisor Leigh Gilbert gave an update. There were 4 permit applications for the month of September, 2014.

Fire Department Log: There were 8 calls during the month of September 2014.

Ambulance Log: There were 49 calls made during the month of September 2014.

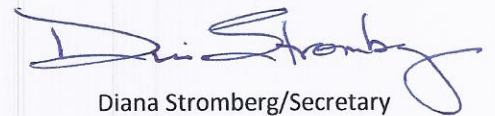
Correspondence: There was no correspondence to report.
