

Paupack Township Board of Supervisors

Meeting Minutes

October 10, 2013

The Paupack Township Board of Supervisors conducted their monthly meeting on Thursday, October 10, 2013 at the Paupack Township Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 P.M. by Chairperson Bruce Chandler.

Chairperson Bruce Chandler opened the meeting by asking all present to participate in the Pledge of Allegiance. The minutes of the September 12, 2013 Supervisors Meeting were presented. A motion was made by Tom Oakley to approve the meeting minutes seconded by Bruce Chandler. All approved.

The Treasurer's Report was presented. Tom Oakley made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report as submitted, seconded by Bruce Chandler. All voted yes to accept the Treasurer's Report.

The bills, totaling \$147,606.44, were presented. Following a review, Tom Oakley made a motion to accept the bills as presented, and pay same, dated September 13, 2013 to October 10, 2013. Bruce Chandler seconded the motion. All voted yes to accept and pay the bills as presented. A list of the bills is on file.

Subdivision; Stoner (2013-7) – This lot consolidation is located in Wallenpaupack Lake Estates. Karl Hennings presented new maps with all conditions set forth by the Township Planning Commission being met. A deed was drawn up and approved by Solicitor Ronnie Fischer. Bruce Chandler made a motion to approve the subdivision seconded by Tom Oakley. All approved.

Fire Department Log: There were 8 calls during the month of September, 2013

Ambulance Log: Tom Oakley gave an explanation regarding changes in personnel at Wayne Ambulance and there was no log available in time for the meeting.

Right To Know Resolution Review: Township Planning Consultant Jim Martin gave an update of his review of the current Township Right To Know resolution. He stated that no changes or revisions need to be made at this time. He also commented that there is a Senate Bill #444 which has been introduced in April 2013 that would amend the Right to Know Act of 2008. The primary revisions are for clarifying several sections of the Right to Know Law and if these changes occur, we will make revisions to the Township resolution.

Building & Zoning Update: Tom Oakley gave an update on building and zoning permits applied for during the month of September, 2013.

Correspondence: Incoming correspondence was addressed by Bruce Chandler

Public Comment: There was a question raised about recent stormwater issues.

There was discussion regarding the Wangaum Bridge and whether it is going to be repaired. Mr. Chandler explained that it is a county bridge and plans have been approved with construction due to begin in Spring/Summer 2014.

Tom Oakley announced that there is a rededication of the Purdytown Cemetery on Saturday, October 12, 2013 and invited all to attend.

Having no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 7:56 PM by Chairperson Bruce Chandler.
