

November 10, 2010

The Paupack Township Board of Supervisors met on the above date at 7:38 P.M. at the Municipal building. The minutes of the October 14, 2010 meeting were presented. Tom Oakley made a motion to accept the minutes seconded by Leigh Gilbert – vote unanimous.

A Treasurer's report was presented. Leigh Gilbert made a motion to accept the report seconded by Tom Oakley –vote unanimous.

S.D. 2010-4- Bridge- (Karl Hennings)- Tom Oakley made a motion to give final approval to this lot combination located in Wallenpaupack Lake Estates seconded by Leigh Gilbert – vote unanimous.

The food pantry will be held on November 18, 2010 from 11:00 A.M. until 2:00 P.M.

Attorney Bugaj gave an update on Big Bear Campground. Bids have been submitted for the sewage system along with financial guarantees from the bank.

Leigh Gilbert gave a report on the October building permits.

The line painting has been completed about three weeks ago.

Robert Boogertman gave an updated report on the new station in WLE. He thanked the Board for all their support. He announced the Fire Company is working on bids to purchase a Suffin tanker around \$253,000.00. Tom Oakley responded to the fire tax money and stated the remainder will be sent out by the end of the month.

The Christopherson property purchased by the township was \$72,500.00. We received \$33,700.00 in state grant money for the property. It has created a water source for the Fire Company and is about 90% full.

Tom Oakley made a motion to schedule a 2011 budget workshop on November 23, 2010 at 3:00 P.M. seconded by Leigh Gilbert – vote unanimous.

Leigh Gilbert addressed an issue brought up by an owner in Port Florence concerning a camper on a piece of property in the same development.

Tom Oakley made a motion for the local Boy Scout Counsel to acquire a log cabin located in Woodloch Pines to be moved over to the Boy Scouts property on Goose Pond Road as a historic structure with exemptions to building permits seconded by Leigh Gilbert - vote unanimous.

Tom Oakley reported that two trucks are in service and one has a hydraulic problem. The salt is being ordered and anti skid is being trucked in by the township. The Board is confident about the salt shed structure. They opted out in having an engineer look at it.

Those present were board members, (Tom, Bruce, Leigh), Secretary, Solicitor and Chairman Chandler who conducted the meeting which adjourned at 8:35 P.M. Names of those present are herein filed.
