The Paupack Township Board of Supervisors met on the above date at 7:30 P.M. at the Municipal Building. Upon review of the minutes from October 8<sup>th</sup> Leigh Gilbert made a motion to approve them as written. There were two yes votes and o no votes. Bruce Chandler abstained from the vote.

A Treasurer's report was given. A copy is herein filed.

The bills were reviewed. Leigh Gilbert made a motion to approve them seconded by Tom Oakley – vote unanimous.

S.D. 2009-12- Anderson – Bruce Chandler made a motion to give final approval to this lot combination located in Sunny point seconded by Tom Oakley –v ote unanimous.

S.D. 2009-13- WD Trust – Tom Oakley made a motion to give final approval to this four lot separation in WLE seconded by Leigh Gilbert – vote unanimous. The deeds were reviewed and found to be in order by Attorney Bugaj.

S.D. 2009-8- Faktor – Upon review of the deeds by Attorney Bugaj Bruce Chandler made a motion to give final approval to this lot combination seconded by Tom Oakley – vote unanimous.

The food pantry will be held on November 19<sup>th</sup> from 11:00 until 2:00.

Another budget workshop will be held on November 18<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 P.M. Bruce announced that we are still waiting for the county paperwork for the assessed valuation for 2010.

Attorney Bugaj announced that the Big Bear septic problem is close to being resolved and the owners are in cooperation with the township.

Leigh Gilbert made a motion for Jim Martin to prepare a resolution for contractors to have a registration number and a notarized affidavit on file with the township seconded by Tom Oakley – vote unanimous.

A discussion concerning a resolution for construction being done in the township without a permit and for the permit fees to be doubled if the construction is being done and if this will be the primary person or the contractor's obligation has been tabled until the December meeting.

Bruce Chandler made a motion to prepare a resolution on subdivision fees collected by the township seconded by Tom Oakley – vote unanimous.

A road master's report was available for the public.

Several correspondence letters were received on various issues for the public to review.

The Supervisors received a letter from Debra Zanzanico concerning several calls she has made to the township tax collector and said she never received any return calls. The Supervisors stated they will pass this along to the tax collector.

The supervisors stated that the salt shed is filled with enough anti skid and salt for now.

In new business, Leigh Gilbert obtained a security surveillance quote from First Alarm Security and stated that he will be receiving two more quotes for the December meeting.

Mr. Rolin Edwards, the Zoning Officer checked into a situation of a possible commercial business being run from a home in the township. He stated that there is no proof of the owner doing this and a written statement is needed.

Those present were board members, (Tom, Bruce, Leigh), Secretary, Solicitor and Chairman Chandler who conducted the meeting which adjourned at 8:25 P.M. Names of those present are herein filed.
