

July 8, 2010

The Paupack Township Board of Supervisors met on the above date at 7:30 P.M. at the Municipal building. The minutes of the June 10th meeting were presented. Leigh Gilbert made a motion to approve the minutes seconded by Tom Oakley – vote unanimous.

A Treasurer's report was given. A copy is herein filed. The bills were presented and reviewed by the board. Tom Oakley made a motion to pay the bills seconded by Leigh Gilbert - vote unanimous.

Mr. Jon Tandy from the Tafton Fire Department made a presentation to the board concerning the side scan sonar for Lake Wallenpaupack. He stated they are still short at least \$10,500.00 and is asking the board to consider funding some of the cost. The board thanked Mr. Tandy for his presentation and told him they will consider it.

S.D. 2010- 2- Martinez - Mr. Kiley presented new maps with the noted changes. After a brief discussion concerning the possibility of the road usage and deed additions Bruce Chandler made a motion to give final approval seconded by Tom Oakley – vote unanimous.

The food pantry will be held from 11:00 until 2:00 on July 22nd.

Tom Oakley announced the purchase of the Christopherson property next to the recreation ground. He stated that a grant was submitted to pay for half of the land. He also mentioned that the state police were there searching for the murder weapon thought to be in the pond. Nothing was found. A permit for a fire hydrant is going to be obtained. The road crew has spent a lot of time and effort cleaning the property and working on enhancing it for walking trails and making it an added addition to the recreation park.

Tom Oakley made a motion for the building to be used for the Wayne County Comprehensive Plan meeting on July 13th at 6:30 P.M. seconded by Leigh Gilbert – vote unanimous.

The board gave an update on Big Bear. Big Bear is in violation of their court order, therefore the supervisors had the water turned off. An inspection has to be made by our SEO for the water to be turned on. After much discussion Tom Oakley made a motion for Attorney Bugaj to pursue action against Big Bear Association and to sign the verification seconded by Leigh Gilbert – vote unanimous.

Dock approvals were received from the Wayne County Conservation District.

A thank you letter was received for the \$7,500.00 donation to the Watershed Management District.

A 2008 liquid fuel audit was received.

Those present were board members, (Bruce, Leigh, Tom), Secretary, Solicitor and Chairman Chandler who conducted the meeting that adjourned at 8:20 P.M. Names of those present are herein filed.
